

## ONLINE APPLICATION PROVISIONS

1. These regulations define the rules for submitting online applications to the European Circular Retail Congress (ECRC, hereinafter: the Congress), held from November 21 to 24, 2022 by European Conferences United Sp. z oo, having its registered office at ul. Ludwinowska 7/16, 30-331 Kraków, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the District Court for the City of Kraków, 11th Economic Division of the National Court Register on November 15, 2002 under KRS number 0000132734, NIP 6762228354 (hereinafter: ECU) and the Conditions for attending the congress.

2. The cost of one person's online participation in the Congress is:

If more than three people from one company register, the company can request an individual offer!

The prices are exclusive of 23% VAT.

3. The price includes unlimited access to all sessions on a given congress day as per registration, as well as conference materials and meals served during the coffee and lunch breaks.

4. After completing the application form available online at <https://circular-retail.eu/>, the applicant will receive an email to the email address specified in the online application form, containing all the essential elements and confirming the concluded contract. The e-mail sent to the applicant confirms the conclusion of a legally binding contract between the applicant and ECU and represents the acceptance of contractual obligations.

5. A proforma invoice will be issued and sent to the applicant's email address or any other email address specified in the online application form within 2 business days of completing the online application form.

6. The person completing the online application form on behalf of the applicant declares that they have the appropriate powers of attorney to act on behalf and for the applicant, in particular to enter into a contract with ECU.

7. Payment must be made within a maximum of 7 days after receipt of the proforma invoice without deduction. Participation in the congress is not possible without paying the full participation fee.

8. If the applicant registers before a date with a price change and does not pay the full participation fee within 7 days after the order has been placed, the costs for one person's participation in the congress will be calculated according to the price list valid on the respective day.

10. The applicant has the right to withdraw from participation in the congress under the following conditions. Withdrawal from participation must be in writing and sent by email to [finance@conferences-united.pl](mailto:finance@conferences-united.pl) and should be confirmed by ECU to ensure withdrawal has been received.

a) In case of cancellation by 09/30/2022, the applicant is obliged to pay a processing fee of PLN 1000 + 23% VAT for each canceled application.

b) In the event of withdrawal after September 30, 2022, the applicant is obliged to pay the full participation costs in the amount resulting from the agreement concluded between the applicant and ECU.

c) In the event of non-participation in the congress and without written withdrawal from participation in the congress, the applicant is obliged to pay the full participation costs in the contractually agreed amount.

11. Failure to pay does not constitute withdrawal from participation in the Congress.

12. The person indicated to attend the Congress may be replaced by another person from the applicant's company/organisation, to be specified by the applicant.

13. The Congress is scheduled as a physical/stationary event only and all applications are for attending the Congress in physical/stationary form.

14. If the pandemic (COVID-19) does not allow the Congress to be organized physically / stationary (based on the laws, regulations and government restrictions in force at that time), the ECU will comply with and in accordance with these laws act . In response to such a situation, the ECU has the right:

- a) change the programme, place, date of the Congress and cancel the Congress, or
- b) change the format of the Congress from a physical/full-time form to a hybrid or online form.

15. Any changes made by the Congress for the reasons described in Section 14 of these Regulations will not automatically change the applicant's financial obligations. In such a case, the ECU Finance Department will determine the policy applicable during the period, which will be considered final.

16. If the local or regional government declares a state of emergency or a natural disaster (other than COVID-19) without allowing time for a response from ECU, ECU reserves the right to change the program and/or date of the congress without the possibility of a refund.

17. All disputes arising from this Agreement shall be dealt with and settled by the court competent for the city in which ECU has its registered office.
